

Students who are currently enrolled in either the ETS or Upward Bound Program may apply for the Kentucky Association of Educational Opportunity Program Personnel scholarships. Applications are available in guidance office and must be postmarked by March 9, 2010.

The Dorothy Preston Silver Memorial Scholarship is a \$500.00 scholarship awarded to a graduating senior who has faced and overcome some type of hardship while in high school that made it extremely difficult to successfully continue toward graduation.
